# MISSA MEETING MINUTES SATURDAY, APRIL 16, 2011 COLUMBIA YACHT CLUB

Sharon Garber called the meeting to order following the first day of racing for the Mallory Qualifer. Team Roll Call: Minnetonka, New Trier, St. Ignatius, Blake, Traverse City, Oconomowoc, Arrowhead, Marquette, Wayzata, Benllde St. Margarets, Southwest, Lake Forest, Lake Forest Academy, Brother Rice, Evanston, Loyola, North Shore, Grosse Pointe North.

## : Review of Proposed 2011-2012 Racing Schedule:

- Cressy Qualifier at Chicago Yacht Club 9/24-9/25, followed by College Singlehanded Championship at CYC
- Great Oaks Qualifier West is slated for Lake Geneva, but may be changed to Pewaukee if necessary. Format will be 1 team per school, same as Great Oaks Championship.
- Pewaukee is interested in hosting a regatta 11/5-11/6 and will follow up.
- MN State Singlehanded Championships is only open to sailors who attend school in MN. (Il State Champs this spring will be open to all states although only IL sailors qualify for title.)
- Spring 2012 Calendar is not yet complete.

## Discussion over moving Mallory Qualifier to Great Lakes Championship

- Suggested by Matt Dubois (not present)
- Vote against adopting change was unanimous.
- Reasons stated: different seasons=different sailors, Great Lakes is 3 class event (A-B-Laser) vs Mallory only A-B, less emphasis on competition in spring
- Next spring shifts back to typical regatta schedule anyhow (this year's change stemmed from College National dates and lack of umpires)

## **Regional Reports**

 All regions gave positive reports. West (MN) looking forward to Baker Qualifier, commented there will be shrouds on flags as at Nationals.

#### **Baker Qualifier**

- to be held 4/30-5/1 at LMSS, MN.
- 11 teams confirmed as of meeting
- Pinneys required, drysuits optional but water is still in 30's
- MISSA sails to be transported by New Trier to MN (currently at Don Shea's house)

Sharon reported Regatta Network will be used for district registration in Fall

## Regatta Registration Deadlines

- Problems with last minute cancellations
- Result in added costs and regatta openings
- Idea of adding a late drop-dead fee suggested by Maggie
- Discussion: ? day/time, universal rule or discretion of host, reinforcement issues in past, JV vs Varsity events, consequences could be liable for payment or can't attend next regatta.
- Motion to adopt a 5 pm, Tuesday deadline for all non-JV events:
- Group vote and drop-dead rule passed for Varsity events.
- Coaches need to be upfront with sailors/parents regarding new policy
- Regatta Network-can it be used for MISSA events
- Used successfully for Cressy Qualifiers by Traverse City in fall

### JV vs Varsity Regattas

- JV regattas/divisions encouraged for developing and mixed teams
- MN holds JV series on weekends
- CYC Rickover Regatta to be held 5/22 (can't have placed 4th or higher)
- Discussion of holding JV event same time as Great Lakes at Columbia this fall.
- Kurt agreed to support idea and "look into it."
- 7th-8th grade feeder programs discussed, and growing teams in general
- Issue:coaching availability when more than 1 regatta held per weekend
- District level teams vs. school teams?
- Issue: top level sailors who don't belong to team
- Who can attend JV events?
- Sharon requested NOR's earlier so teams can review eligibility
